
17-18 July After Conference International Conference in both venue and online live streaming.

The recordings of the live streaming will be broadcast for about 1 week


in the virtual platform.

- 1. When your uploading account is set up, the Secretariat will inform you with the uploading instruction.
- 2. To access to the virtual platform, you need to complete the registration online.
- 3. After registration, you will have access to the platform from the "my page" of the registration site.

3. On the Presentation Day
